The Postal Service has once again updated "their" F-1 Scheduler and has informed the Union that the South Jersey P&DC is over complement. The number of positions are around 25, but this number keeps changing. We will continue to update the membership as new information becomes available.


The date of the action is scheduled for is May 12, 2018, and 60 day letters to be sent out by March 13, 2018

The NPMHU will challenge all moves being made by management. The Union will never agree with the Postal Service on how many duty assignments this building should have and will fight to keep everyone in place.

The South Jersey Managers cannot answer simple questions. When asked about the MHAs the Service had no answer. This action is six (6) months away and will change as we move closer to the impact date. When the Union gets new information we will share it with the membership.
