Dear Brothers and Sisters,

In a meeting earlier today the Mail Handlers Union along with members of the APWU met with local management to discuss potential changes to the mail processing operation should the ill-advised change to the Postal service standards occur. As many of you know, PMG Donahoe has proposed degrading the service standards and slowing the mail. We were informed that the timeline for these changes would be January 5, 2015 and the effective date of any bid restructuring would be January 10, 2015. The Union suggested ways to minimize impact particularly if the change to the service standard does not change, in either case, we intend to monitor any staffing modification to ensure that it complies with the contract, if it doesn't, we will take the appropriate action. The exact impact to the mail handler craft is not yet known and as soon as any additional information is provided to us by management we will pass it along.
